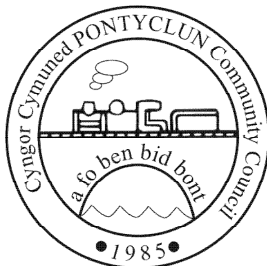

  1. Housing Development in Brynsadler. " Pontyclun Community Council agrees to writing a letter to RCT objecting to any further development of housing in the immediate area of Pontyclun village, Brynsadler, Llanharry or any other area where traffic resulting from the development is most likely to use the A4222 through the villages or the population of such new development could be expected to use Pontyclun Railway Station. The letter should include the fact that the current sever traffic problems in these areas

and the lack of station parking make such developments totally unacceptable to existing residents.”

2. Sainsbury’s Development “Pontyclun Community Council writes to RCT and the developers deploring the wanton destruction of trees along the south side boundary of the A473 between the MacDonald’s roundabout and the junction with the A4222, along with the destruction of a large area of Pant Marsh. The trees were largely on the road side of the land boundary and hence the destruction must have been approved by RCT. In the view of this Council, there was no need for the destruction of the boundary trees inside or outside the development boundary.”
