## 2. Reports from Members

## (a) Community Council Allotments Competition

Councillor Norman reported that judges from the Pencoed Horticultural College had carried out their inspections of allotments and had been encouraged to find a high degree of participation in the year's competition.

#### (b) Straying Animals Working Party

Councillor Mrs Phillips reported on her attendance at the last meeting of the Borough Council's Straying Animals Working Party. Councillor Phillips reported that there had been a proposal to create a pound for straying animals at Ely Street, Pontyclun. The proposal had subsequently been withdrawn.

#### (c) Education Committee - Polytechnic of Wales

of the Polytechnic, but the proposal had not won majority support. Councillor Bowen also reported that the National Association of Teachers in Further Education had made strong representations against any further cuts in education spending.

## (a) Disposal of restaurant waste

Councillor James reported that a local restaurant proprietor had not been using bins or plastic bags to dispose of rubbish from his restaurant. Following complaints of rats having been seen in the vicinity, the Environmental Health Officer had visited the premises and the proprietor had been warned about his practices.

The report was noted.

### (b) Tar spraying in side streets

Councillor Norman reported that he had received several complaints about the poor standard of tar spraying which had recently been carried out in Pontyclun sidestreets. No preparatory work had been undertaken, several areas in streets had been missed, and very little prior warning had been given to residents. Councillor Norman said that he would be taking the matter up with both the Borough Council and County Council.

The report was noted.

#### (c) Notice of Motion

Councillor Norman gave notice of his intention to raise the matter of dog fouling at the next meeting of the Community Council.
