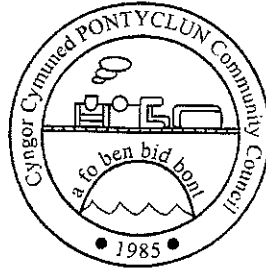

1. **Apologies for absence**

Apologies for absence were received on behalf of Community Councillors D. Clayton-Jones, D Hayes and M Rea.

2. **Declarations of Interest**

3. **Precept for the 2007/08 financial year**

The Council reviewed its income and expenditure to 31 December, 2006, its projected income and expenditure to 31 March, 2007, discussed its plans for providing services in the Community during the 2007/08 financial year and produced a budget for 2007/08.

- RESOLVED:**
- (i) That, based on the Council's budget for 2007/08, a precept of £106,000 be levied upon the Rhondda Cynon Taf County Borough Council.
 - (ii) That the Clerk find out whether other community councils in the Borough provide public conveniences.

- (iii) That the Clerk ask the Borough Council whether it would be prepared to make a contribution to festive lighting in Pontyclun at Christmas, 2007.
- (iv) That the Clerk ask the Borough Council whether it would be prepared to make a contribution to the proposed new footpath at Cefn yr Hendy.
- (v) That the Community Council consult with residents in the vicinity of the Pontyclun War Memorial for their views on the construction of a memorial garden adjacent to the War Memorial and, if necessary, consider budgeting for any expenditure in 2008/09.
- (vi) That the Council endorse the action of the Clerk in seeking comments from the Borough Council on the apparent small increase in the Council Tax Base for 2007/08.
