

CYNGOR CYMUNED PONTYCLUN COMMUNITY COUNCIL

Minutes of the meeting of the Finance Committee held at the Pontyclun Community Centre, Pontyclun, at 7.00pm on Monday, 23 September 1985.

Present: Community Councillors Dr I D Bowen, E J Francis, R C Kennard, R G Norman, and O P Phillips.

I. Expenditure for the 1985/86 financial year

The Committee considered the Council's precept allocation of £18,000, under notional budget heads, the expenditure of the Council to 30 September 1985 and the projected expenditure of the Council to 31 March 1986.

Bearing in mind that the Council had not yet finalised its insurance requirements, and that it wished to incur expenditure on the refurbishment of the public conveniences in Pontyclun, a public address system at the Community Centre, and the Logo Competition it seemed probable that at the current rate of expenditure a projected surplus of about £400 would be achieved.

Recommended: That the Council's level of expenditure continue at its present rate and that provision be made within the Authority's budget for 1985/86 for the following additional items:-

- (i) Refurbishment of the public conveniences in Llantrisant Road, Pontyclun.
- (ii) Public address system at the Community Centre.
- (iii) Logo Competition

2. Refurbishment of the public conveniences

The Committee received two tenders for the refurbishment works to be carried out at the public conveniences. They were:-

- (i) £1644.04 - I J Balman, Llantrisant.
- (ii) £2305.75 - B Y D Construction and Demolition, Treforest.

Recommended: That the contract for the works be awarded to Mr I J Balman of Llantrisant.

3. Community Premises

The Committee considered the desirability of providing a Community/Day Centre/Office within the Community.

Recommended: That the Council give consideration to the establishment of a Sinking Fund to provide finance for a Community/Day Centre/Office.

4. Storage of Council's Tools and Equipment

Recommended: That the Council make enquires of the County Council to ascertain whether facilities for the storage of tools and equipment could be arranged at the premises of the School Playing Fields Unit. In the event of the County Council being unable to assist enquiries be made within the Community with a view to hiring a garage.

5. Footbridge at the Ivor Park

Members heard that soil erosion had taken place at the football field end of the footbridge to the Ivor Park and of the possible need for remedial works.

Recommended: That urgent arrangements be made for the examination of the bridge by the Welsh Water Authority (Land Drainage Section).
