### **Walking Routes/maps:**

Discussion on promoting Pontyclun as a centre for walkers and therefore an increase in visits to the area is seen as a benefit.

The meeting was informed that funding to produce walking leaflets for the Pontyclun area had been identified through the Ramblers Cymru. The organisation has a great deal of experience in producing such leaflets and a template of an example was shown to the meeting.

The meeting agreed to pursue this option provided that:

- The PCC supply the description of routes and any historical information;
- The PCC supply photographs;
- The PCC supply a route map drawn onto an Ordnance Survey map.

In addition the PCC would choose the colour scheme and use our preferred logo on the leaflets.

Ramblers Cymru will produce the mapping, produce versions of the leaflet in the Welsh language and do some printing.

A budget for the Walking Route leaflets has already been agreed by the Council but with the involvement of Ramblers Cymru, this can now be used for waymarking the routes.

There is every chance that PCC will be able to produce up to three updated walking leaflets by the end of this year.

The Economy working group commends this plan to the Community Council and seeks agreement at the April meeting.
