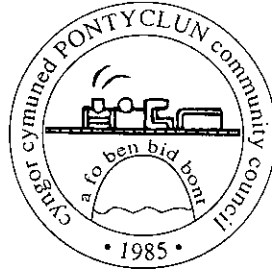

Minutes of the special meeting of the Pontyclun Community Council held in the Pontyclun Community Centre, Pontyclun, at 8.00 p.m. on Wednesday, 14 January, 1998.

1. **Apology for absence**

An apology for absence was received on behalf of Community Councillor C G Bendle.

2. **Matters deferred from the Council's meeting of 7 January, 1998**

A wide ranging discussion took place on the utilisation of the Community Council's reserves, ways in which additional facilities could be made available for the youth of the Community, environmental projects for further discussion with Groundwork Merthyr and Rhondda Cynon Taff, and on ways in which the Community Council's achievements could be brought to the attention of residents.
