2. Hard surface play area

The sub committee met following a request by the Council at its meeting on 4 February, 1998, to identify possible sites in Pontyclun for the construction of a hard surface play area.

RECOMMENDED: That in addition to the site already identified at the new residential development on Cefn yr Hendy, the Council consider further sites of approximately 40 feet by 20 feet at the following locations:

- (a) the car park adjacent to the Pontyclun Football Club ground of Cowbridge Road
- (b) a site adjacent to St Paul's Church, Pontyclun, where demolition work had recently taken place
- (c) the back garden of Van's Bingo Hall
- (d) the strip of land to the west of the highway connecting Maelog Close with Merthyr Street
- (e) the strip of land at the river end of Merthyr Street connecting with the river end of Lewis Street

- (f) a plot on the south eastern section of the Windsor Fields.
- (g) a site at the former goods yard adjacent to Pontyclun railway station (as a joint venture with a neighbouring community council)
- (h) a site on a field in front of Mill Farm
- (i) a site on the Maesyfelin Rugby Field formerly occupied by the cricket pavilion of the Pontyclun Cricket Club.
